
Kindergarten & 1st Grade

KINDERGARTEN *Full Day Kindergarten-9:15-2:45

Our Kindergarten class size is limited to 14 children, promoting opportunities for more individualized instruction. We utilize Starfall and Starfall Math Curriculums, and implement Writers Workshop, utilizing the Lucy Calkins model. The <u>Starfall Curriculum</u> is research based and field tested. It incorporates reading and language art skills and strategies with social studies and science, and employs technology in the classroom. The curriculum meets and exceeds PA Standards for Kindergarten. *Full Day First Grade-9:00-3:00

Our 1st Grade class size is 10 children for a smaller class size and individual instruction. We use the McGraw Hill Curriculum and implement gym, art, music and excitement into our daily learning. Report cards and conferences are given. The curriculum enhances and moves forward from our Kindergarten Curriculum. The requirements meet and exceed PA standards of Learning for First Grade. You can add before and after care if needed with your families schedules.



Kindergarten Connection

Happy New Year to you and your family! The goal of the Kindergarten Connection for T.E.C.E.C. is to provide information to current and prospective Kindergarten families. Our current Kindergarten class has been having an amazing year! Through the Starfall curriculum, students are making tremendous progress towards becoming independent readers and are also familiarizing themselves with American Sign Language. Our mascot, Backpack Bear, is a constant friend who motivates his classmates to grow and explore. Our math curriculum, Starfall Mathematics, is carefully designed to build and expand a student's mathematical proficiency and understanding. During Writer's Workshop, students will continue to strive to write stories with a beginning, middle and end. If you are considering our program for your child next year, please do not hesitate to talk with Mrs. Strutko, Mrs. Collins, Ms. Nelson, Mrs. Banks, or any of our current Kindergarten parents. If you are interested in a possible First Grade, please be sure to fill out the survey that was sent home.

During January, children will review each letter and its sound and we will begin discovering vowels. Learning to blend these letters and sounds to make words makes for very excited early readers. The Kindergarteners are doing an amazing job at writing and illustrating books in Writer's Workshop with Ms. Nelson on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons!

We will begin a discussion about our Solar System including planets and constellations. As part of the fun, together as a class we will write a story about an imaginary walk through the night sky! The class will continue to practice using their "kid writing" to write about their illustrations. We have been enjoying our Top Secret Reader on Friday afternoons in which a child's family member comes in as a surprise reader to read a fvorite story to the class!





Note to Kindergarten Parents: Kindergarten students will go outside for recess daily, weather permitting. Please dress your child appropriately for the colder weather. When we have a significant amount of snow, we will go outside to play in it. It will be necessary to send in snow clothes and boots at that time. It is very helpful that your child is able to put on winter gear independently including fastening buttons, snaps, zippers, and putting on boots and gloves.
